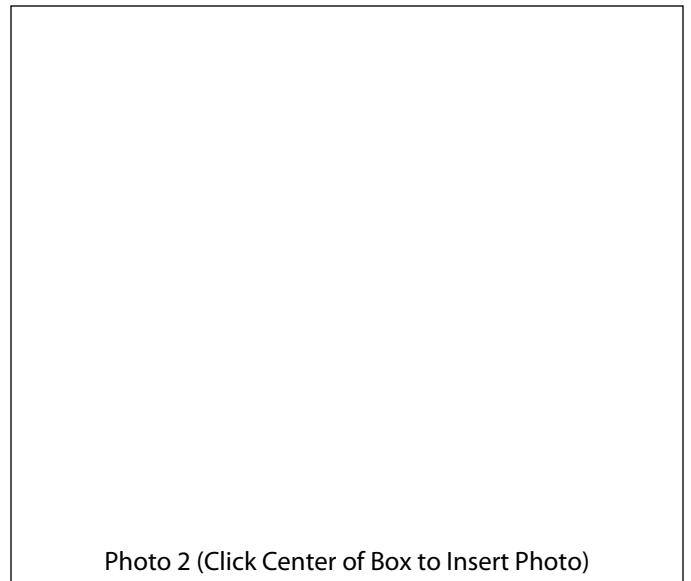
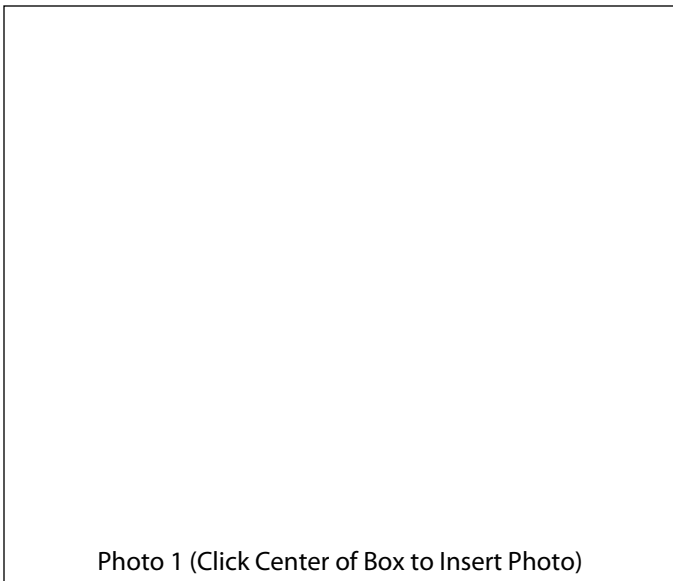

Tips on writing a description of your pet: Use the following page to write a description of your pet. This is the place to describe your pet's unique personality, favorite things to do, toys, etc. Highlight interesting characteristics of the animal such as interesting markings or special talents. Comments such as "loyal companion" or "I can sit and shake hands" might be just the thing that gets an animal noticed, and placed in a new home. Take this opportunity to describe the ideal home for your pet such as "loves long walks" or "likes to cuddle up next to you". Try to convey the animal's special needs by emphasizing the "special" aspect. Rather than stating that the pet "hates other animals." for instance, write that she/he "would be best as an only pet. "If a dog requires extra attention, don't say he "suffers severe separation anxiety"; instead write that he "needs an at-home mom or dad. Be certain to describe any known medical conditions, current medication or ongoing treatment that will be required. It is never a good idea to mislead potential adopters about an animal's true nature, medical condition or possible behavior problems, but you can use the adoption consultation time to discuss the details of particular issues.
